## Smithville Christian High School Exam Day Expectations

1. **Hand in your textbooks or their replacement value at least 25 minutes before the exam is scheduled to begin. In the event that the textbook or the replacement fee has not been received you may not write the exam.**
2. Be sure to have extra pens, and, in math, pencils, geometry set and calculator.
3. Upon the announcement enter the gym without talking and find a seat in the designated row for your exam.
4. Use of personal electronic devices is absolutely prohibited, including as calculators. Only scientific or programmable calculators may be used. Translators used by international students may not have wireless internet capabilities. Any student who shows evidence of disobeying these expectations will forfeit the right to complete his/her exam, and will be assessed a mark of zero on the exam.
5. In the exam room gum, food and drinks are not permitted, with the exception of bottled water.
6. There is to be absolutely no talking in the gym.
7. **The uniform dress code will be in effect during examinations.**
8. After teacher announcements and prayer you may begin your exam. You have two hours to complete your exam. In the event that you are finished early you may leave, provided the supervising teaching has announced that the **one hour minimum** time has elapsed. Students will not be allowed to leave the exam room unless it's an emergency. If an emergency arises, a teacher will accompany the student out of the exam room.
9. **Upon completion you may quickly go to your lockers but loitering in the halls is not permitted.** After your exam you are encouraged to go home and study for your next exam. If you are unable to find a ride home you may study in the lounge or library.
10. The library is a designated quiet study area.
11. In the event of a snow day the structure of the exam schedule and promotion/turnaround days will be moved back one day but the exam order will not change.
