

## Spiritual Emphasis Week 2010

Here's a sneak peak at Spiritual Emphasis Week 2010, featuring Lindsay Janssen, Mark McDermott, Pastor Craig Danielson and Smithville Christian's own Praise Teams.



Each day started with a time of praise and worship led by one of the Praise Teams, followed by an inspiring and challenging message from Pastor Craig. The school timetable was adjusted to accommodate the morning assembly, and to allow for small group break-out sessions later in the day. Each of the small groups was facilitated by a student leader. Here's a summary of the topics covered each day.

### **God** (I will choose to do the right thing)

**Monday Feb. 8<sup>th</sup>, 2010**

Read the story of Noah. Read Genesis 6:9. Stop there and just think about the kind of person this describes. Could this be you?

### **You** (I will believe what God says about me...I'm NEW)

**Tuesday Feb. 9<sup>th</sup>, 2010**

Read 2 Corinthians 5:17 today. Think about how Christ has made you a new person. Or let someone know if you'd like Him to.

### **Community** (I will seek out healthy relationships)

**Wednesday Feb. 10<sup>th</sup>, 2010**

Let's find out more about Elisha. Look up 1 Kings 19. Sounds like Elisha and Elijah needed each other. I pray your group can be that for you.

### **Others** (I will focus on the needs of others before myself)

**Thursday Feb. 11<sup>th</sup>, 2010**

Read Philippians 2:3-4. Easier said than done right? How will you live this today?

### **Shine** (I will be a light and tell others my story)

**Friday Feb. 12<sup>th</sup>, 2010**

Jesus' last words were a big send-out for all of us. Read Matthew 28:18-20 and think about what it means to you.

People who VALUE your soul

People who PRAISE your journey.
